Applicants Must:

- Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to a career in the food industry. Priority will be given to applicants with prior experience in food service.
- Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years old.
- Applicants must demonstrate at least 3 months of being clean, sober and free of drugs/alcohol.
- Applicants must have a state-issued ID, working telephone contact and a permanent address.
- Applicants must complete the application, available at Moveable Feast, and return it to Moveable Feast by Friday, December 12th, 2014
- Applicant must provide a letter of referral from a case manager or other professional reference.
- Applicants must successfully complete an initial interview.
- Applicants must pass a screening process, which includes: basic reading and math skills assessments, drug screenings and background checks.
- Applicants must commit to attending every day of the 12-week program.
- Applicants must attend a MANDATORY information session on Wednesday, December 17th, 2014.
